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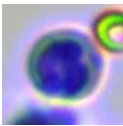
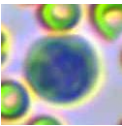
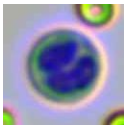
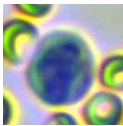
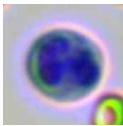
Distribution Chart



Neutrophil stab granulocytes

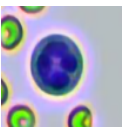


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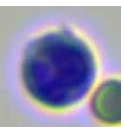
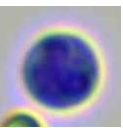
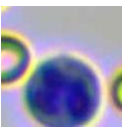
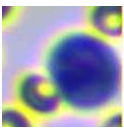
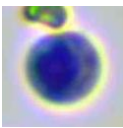
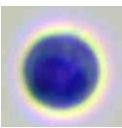
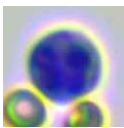
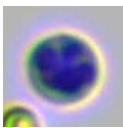
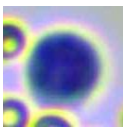
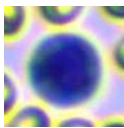

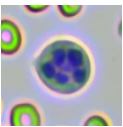
Neutrophil segmented granulocytes



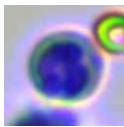

Clinical Significance

Neu#	Elevated levels: It is suggested that various acute infections, inflammations, stress reactions, some hematological diseases, toxic diseases, etc.
Nsg#	Elevated levels: It is suggested that various acute infections, inflammations, stress reactions, some hematological diseases, toxic diseases, etc.
HGB	Decreased levels: It is common in anemia caused by various reasons, such as hemolytic anemia, blood loss and anemia caused by parasitic infection.
HCT	Decreased levels: It is common in anemia caused by various reasons.
PLT	Decreased levels: It is common in sample agglutination, such as physiological agglutination in cats, poor anticoagulation after sampling and long-term storage; Accelerated platelet clearance due to various causes, such as primary immune-mediated thrombocytopenia and secondary immune-mediated thrombocytopenia due to autoimmune diseases, tumors, infectious diseases, canine distemper attenuated vaccination, protozoal infection, dirofilariasis, histoplasmosis, and immune complex vasculitis;It is occasionally seen in abnormal platelet production caused by drugs, infections, vaccines, and defective platelet production.
PCT	Decreased levels: Indicating thrombocytopenia.
