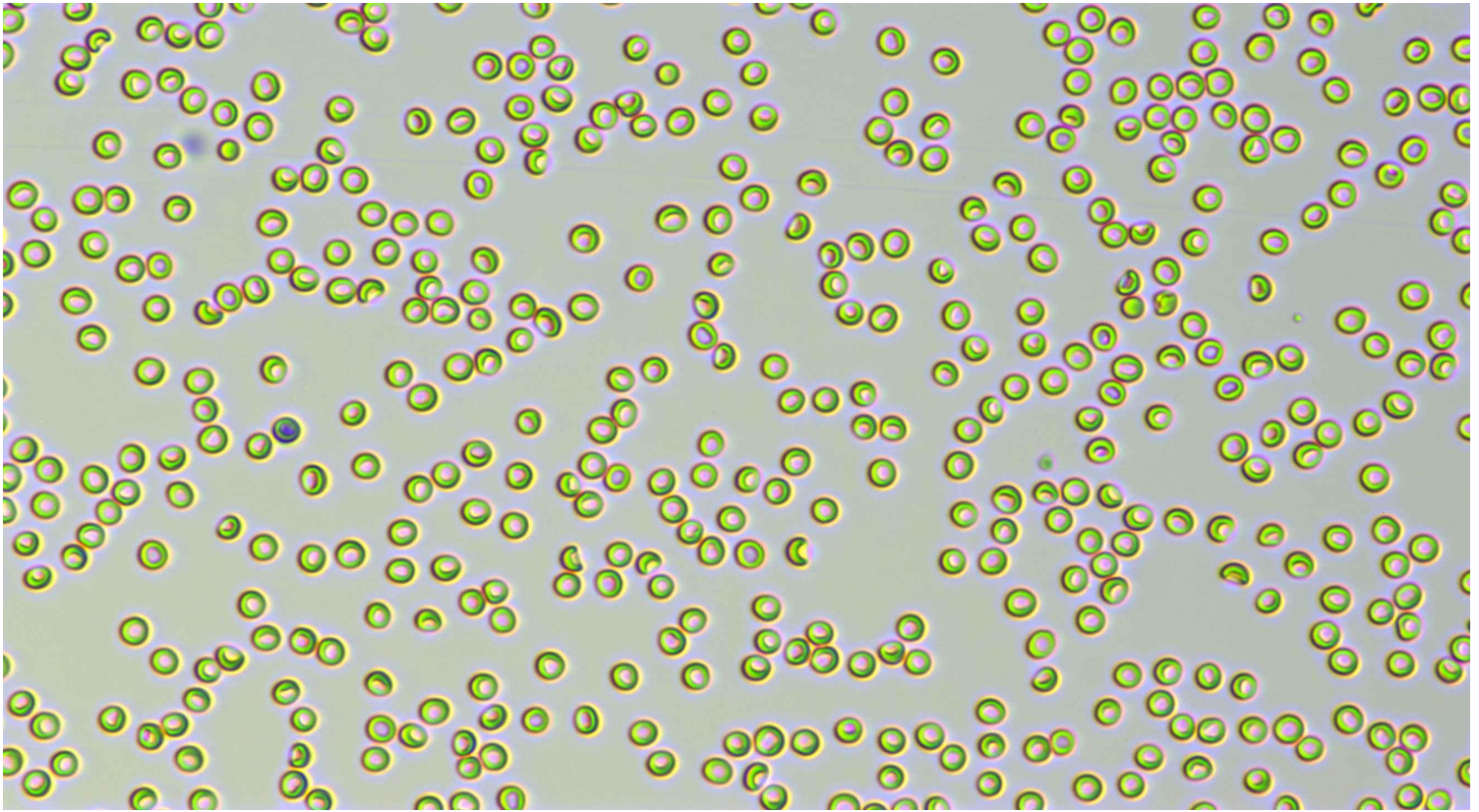
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Distribution Chart

Clinical Significance

Decreased levels: It is common in sample agglutination, such as physiological agglutination in cats, poor anticoagulation after sampling and long-term storage; Accelerated platelet clearance due to various causes, such as primary immune-mediated thrombocytopenia and secondary immune-mediated thrombocytopenia due to autoimmune diseases, tumors, infectious diseases, canine distemper attenuated vaccination, protozoal infection, dirofilariasis, histoplasmosis, and immune complex vasculitis; It is occasionally seen in abnormal platelet production caused by drugs, infections, vaccines, and defective platelet production.
